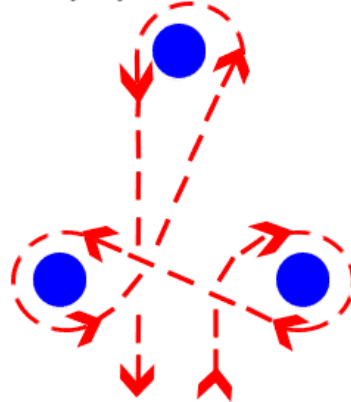


## 4D Quad Barrel Racing ----- Rules of Competition

Competitor can choose to  
go to Right Barrel or Left Barrel  
Must complete the Cloverleaf  
Pattern.

- Description of Quads
  - Utility Quad – Hunting / Farm style 4 Wheeler
  - Sport Quad – Racing style 4 Wheeler
  - Side By Side – 2 seater style, Polaris, Mule, Ranger, Chuckwagon, etc.
  
- Quad Barrel Racing is a timed event using three identical barrels set in a cloverleaf pattern.
  
- The start/finish line and the barrel positions are permanently marked and will remain the same throughout the entire event.
  
- Any time a contestant crosses the starting line, time will begin.
  
- A contestant will be given a “no time” for:
  - Going Off Pattern.
  - Knocking Over a Barrel
  
- The pattern will meet the following conditions:
  - a minimum of 15 feet between each of the first two barrels and the side fence.
  - a minimum of 30 feet between the third barrel and the back fence.
  - a minimum of 30 feet between the time line and the first barrel.

- A contestant will be disqualified and asked to leave the premises if:
  - Doughnuts are made in parking lot or barn area
  - Burnouts
  - Consumption of Alcohol or Drugs
  - Possession of Firearms Strictly Prohibited
  
- Contestants can enter more than once. Paying the required entry fee for each time entered.
  
- Run positions will be randomly drawn with contestants entering more than once being spaced out.
  
- All Contestants MUST wear helmets.
  
- Youth Contestants (Ages 12 years and under)
  - Entry Fees are \$10/run
  - Trophies will be given to the top ten Youth
  - A Youth must enter the Youth class or the Open....Youth cannot enter both classes.
  - All Youth contestants will receive a Certificate of Participation

## 4-D format

All riders, regardless of ability, run in the same 4-D barrel race. The four divisions are then determined by time brackets. With the 4-D format, the OVERALL fastest time of the race is used to set the time brackets for the four divisions. . \* 1st Division: These are the riders with the fastest times. \* 2nd Division: These are competitors who ran ONE-HALF (1/2) SECOND or SLOWER than the OVERALL fastest time. \* 3rd Division: These are competitors who ran ONE (1) SECOND or SLOWER than the OVERALL fastest time. \* 4th Division: These are competitors who ran TWO (2) SECONDS or SLOWER than the OVERALL fastest time.

1D – 35%

2D – 30%

3D – 20%

4D – 15%
